Our NDIS lessons are provided by our professional teachers, who each have extensive experience in teaching people of all abilities in a fun, engaging, hands on, and inspiring way. Our NDIS lessons focus on developing musical skills, techniques, and theory, whilst learning to play an instrument. Lessons may also include singing and movement.

Each student will be issued an invoice by end of Week 1, Term 3. Students will be invoiced in full for a Term long booking. Invoices will be based on a students individual Term 3 lesson plan. Invoices will include our 2025 payment and missed lesson information.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON NDIS LESSONS



1. It remains the NDIS participant/carer responsibility to ensure their music lessons at King St Music School can be funded under the NDIS. King St Music School is not listed as a registered NDIS provider.
2. It is up to the NDIS participant/carer to pass on our invoices to the NDIS for claiming. The NDIS participant/carers will let us know if specific information is needed on the invoice so that it is able to be claimed.
3. Payment of term invoices remain the responsibility of the NDIS participant/carer. King St Music School is not involved in the claiming process through the NDIS. We understand payment for music lessons will vary depending on the provider.

4. If your NDIS participant funding falls short, or a provider does not pay an invoice in full, the outstanding invoice amount remains the responsibility of the NDIS participant/carer, and required by the due date.
