Term Bookings. Paid in Full All inclusive 10-Week Term

Students will pay in full for the term, the amount shown on their individual invoice. Payments are to be made in full by the due date on the invoice.

Our pay-in-full pricing is for a term-long booking. The total cost is to secure your lesson time for the term, with payment made for missed lessons. Each student will be issued an invoice by the end of week 1 of the Term, or following their first lesson. Invoices will be based on a student's individual lesson plan, and will be for the full term amount.

Where payment is not received by the due date, a **late payment fee of \$20.00** will be generated and will appear on each individual invoice.

In order to meet the needs of all our students and teachers, we require all invoices to be paid in full by the due date.

Invoice reminders will be issued throughout the term for outstanding amounts. This is to ensure we are all up to date with our payments. We aim to resolve any payment disputes as they arise.

Accepted invoice payment methods are direct deposit, card payments in person, and cash payments.

Card payments in person will incur an additional 1.9% transaction fee.

Lesson fees are non-refundable or credited.

Separate invoicing will apply throughout school holiday periods.

Missed Lessons

As our teachers are fully booked into 2026, King St Music School can only accommodate make-up lessons during school holidays. With a limit to each student of two make-up lessons only, each term.

Please note that missed lessons cannot be rescheduled into the following term, and are not able to be credited towards future student invoices.

Please note our operating hours, lesson times, and teacher availability will differ during school holidays.

It is important to us that students who are unwell do not attend their music lesson. This is to ensure we all stay safe and well throughout the term. If unable to attend a lesson, please provide as much notice as possible prior to your scheduled lesson time.

To reduce the impact of missed lessons, enquire about a lesson swap, request new music from your teacher to practice at home, or have a sibling, parent, or friend attend the lesson in your place.

Your teacher has prepared your lesson in advance, and we encourage students to ask for music to practice at home. We are happy to email any requested materials to you.
